The Census Bureau determines the federal poverty threshold according to household size for the entire United States each year. For a household of four, the 2017 threshold is \$24,600. According to the Census Bureau's most recent Official Poverty Measure, California ranks 17th-highest, with a 15 percent poverty rate.

Poverty remains dramatically higher among Latinos and less-educated adults. In 2018, 22.9% of Latinos lived in poverty, compared to 18.2% of African Americans, 15.9% of Asian Americans/Pacific Islanders, and 12.8% of whites, as PPIC's interactive shows. ### Poverty Guidelines | USCIS

The poverty guidelines are the other version of the federal poverty measure. They are issued each year in the Federal Register by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS). The guidelines are a

simplification of the poverty thresholds for use for administrative purposes — for instance, determining financial eligibility for certain federal programs.

### **Poverty Guidelines | ASPE**

What is poverty? The US Census Bureau determines the Federal Poverty Level each year. The poverty level is based on the size of the household and the ages of family members. If a person or family's total income before taxes is less than the poverty level, the person or family are considered in poverty.

### **Poverty | OEHHA**

To qualify for a subsidy from the government, families must purchase their coverage through Covered California, and have a gross income no more than 400% of the federal poverty level. To also qualify for cost sharing reductions, your family gross income must be more than 138% and less than 250% of the federal poverty level.

### **Federal Poverty Level: Health Insurances Cost Standards**

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$4,480 for each additional person. \*Modified Adjusted Gross Income
